Trelleborg Rubber Flooring manufactures and sells rubber flooring. The company's offices and factory are both situated in Trelleborg, southern Sweden. This allows us to control production from beginning to end. Our goal is to produce high quality rubber flooring for public areas and industry where the demands for durability, good design and safety are extremely high. Our production complies with all existing environmental legislation as well as the Group's own high environmental goals.

**Natural raw materials**

All our rubber flooring is manufactured using a unique design process whereby we vulcanise three separate layers together to form a single homogeneous material. The hardwearing outer layer and softer intermediate rubber provide excellent sound-proofing. The flooring also makes working long hours more comfortable by providing vital support to backs and joints. The polyester weave backing allows the use of environmentally friendly, water-based glues. In addition to being PVC-free, the natural raw materials can be recycled. Trelleborg rubber flooring is fire safe, withstands cigarette burns and has a good resistance to discoloration and chemicals.

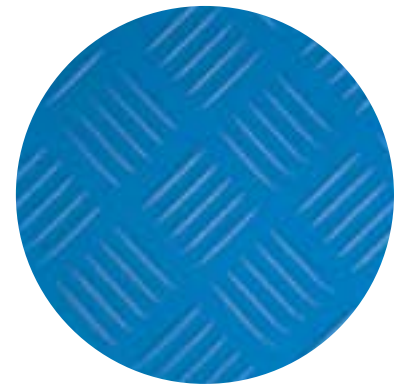

Checker comes in a wide range of bold and bright shades – there are 28 different colours to choose from! Checker flooring is very quiet to walk on and the pattern provides effective non-slip protection, making it the perfect flooring for public areas where the demands for durability, safety and comfort are high.

Checker creates the right atmosphere in shops, offices, stairways, corridors and entrances, etc. It is also excellent for terminals, waiting rooms, libraries, universities and other public areas.

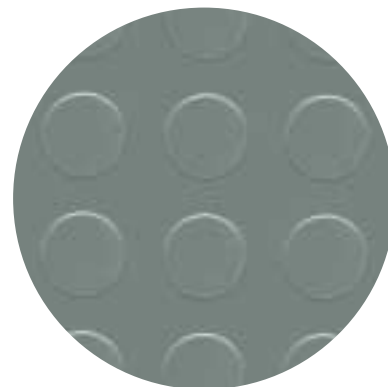




## CHECKER® STUD

Checker Stud is equally as hardwearing as Checker but offers a different surface appearance with small round rubber studs. Although the surface is bright, it is not as pronounced as Checker thanks to the use of more earthy colours like olive green, marine blue, wine red and several shades of brown and green. This discreet, hardwearing flooring offers virtually unlimited possibilities to match your interior design.

Checker Stud also provides excellent sound-proofing while a thicker intermediate layer of rubber guarantees excellent comfort underfoot making it perfect for areas with high levels of pedestrian traffic.

Checker Stud is the perfect choice in public areas with heavy pedestrian traffic such as terminals, corridors, waiting rooms, airports and shops.





## Comfortable and quiet

With its discreet pattern, C1 is the ideal flooring for conference and office environments. Other areas of use include hospitals, lecture halls and similar environments.



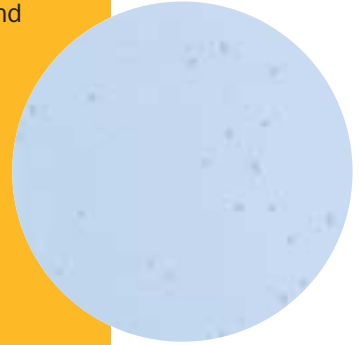
## Endless design combinations

Confetti is hardwearing flooring suitable for areas with heavy foot traffic such as offices, shops, hospitals, schools and nursery schools.



### C1™

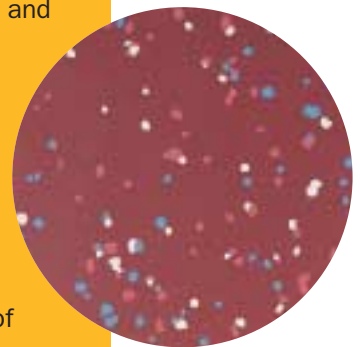
C1 flooring is soft, quiet and extremely durable. One distinguishing feature of the C1 design are the small, sparsely distributed colour flakes, in contrast to Confetti and C2 which have larger colour flakes. The colour flakes accentuate the base colours to give your flooring a discreet and elegant appearance. C1 flooring is, of course, also quiet to walk on and is available in 12 colour combinations. The lightly grained, matt surface provides a firm foot grip. C1 is not recommendable in environments that are exposed to heavy traffic such as entrances and hallways.



### CONFETTI®

If you want to create your own unique flooring design then Confetti offers fantastic possibilities. Confetti flooring comes in 28 basic colours, all of which can be freely mixed and combined. Choose one, two or three colour flakes and simply add them to your chosen base colour. In addition, there are three different colour flake densities. This means 1.5 million possible colour combinations – the market's biggest selection of flooring patterns!

You can also choose one of our 13 standard patterns or order Confetti in a single colour. The choice is always yours. Confetti flooring is intended for public areas where the demands for design and durability are high.







## Robust and dirt resistant

The C2's dense colour pattern makes it ideal for use in schools, childcare centres, youth centres, offices and entrances, etc. C2 is tough flooring for demanding environments.

### C<sup>2</sup>™

C2 flooring consists of specially selected colour flakes in 16 standard combinations. Depending on the colour you can either create a floor that stands out on its own or one that highlights your interior design. Each pattern is made up of four different colours, thus offering enormous design possibilities. C2 enjoys our unique combination of durability, comfort and good impact sound attenuation. The grained surface is reflection free and extra dirt resistant thanks to a pattern that does not show dirt and dust in the same way as single coloured flooring. These qualities make C2 ideal for use in offices and locations with high traffic such as entrances and corridors in schools and childcare centres.
